URGENT WEEKLY FAMILY UPDATE

Grand Traverse Pavilions update for residents and responsible parties during COVID-19

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URGENT MESSAGE: As you are aware, we mailed an informational letter to families and guardians last week regarding the Pfizer vaccine and a consent form. This update contains an urgent message about the most recent information.

We have been informed that we will receive the first dose of the COVID vaccine on January 4th through the 7th. Everyone who has provided consent will receive the vaccine.

No appointment is necessary. Pavilions staff will ensure all residents are brought to the vaccine clinic in the main building. We will have the cottages vaccinated at each cottage.

The second dose will be 28 days after the initial dose and the pharmacy will return at that time to administer the second vaccine dose. A third clinic will be held to administer the second dose for those individuals who received their initial dose during the second clinic. There will not be a provision to receive an initial dose at the third clinic.

It is important to note that we were initially told that we would receive the Pfizer vaccine however the pharmacy has stated that we were switched to the Moderna vaccine by the government. Please read the information provided on the Moderna vaccine.

We have also posted the informed consent which needs to be filled out prior to administration.
