## Grand Traverse Pavilions update for residents and responsible parties during COVID-19

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In response to the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) all nursing homes in the state are mandated to test non-vaccinated staff and residents for COVID-19. We are also required to notify residents, families and staff of any positive COVID results.

This week we have completed testing as mandated by CMS, and there were again no new COVID positive staff or residents identified. We encourage you to stay informed by continuing to review the Family Weekly Updates.

As of this message all other are allowing scheduled visitations, as are the Cottages. The current policy allows for limited indoor visits, and outdoor visits with very little restrictions for those residents who are fully vaccinated.

As infection rates in the area increase we wanted to provide some clarification about how the Pavilions determines the current infection rate. All Nursing Homes in Michigan are required to operate based on the most current Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) data related to current COVID positivity rate data they provided weekly. As of September 9, 2021, CMS published the infection rate for Grand Traverse County at 7.9% a slight increase from the rate reported by CMS last week. New criteria has been proposed by CMS to reflect the "community spread rate" (9%) vs. the community positivity rate. It is anticipated that it may be necessary to transition to the new reporting tool as early as next week. For more information visit CMS Website w/ COVID Community Spread Rate.

As required we have developed a plan to address the positivity rates (and community spread rates) should they continue to rise. You will find this plan posted on the website. Please understand that we are following recommendations, regulations and best practices from MDHHS, CMS and CDC.

You may be aware that the Biden administration has announced that all nursing home staff become fully vaccinated. At this time we are waiting for CMS to publish the requirements for staff vaccination and the effective date. We continue to provide education and access to the vaccination for both residents and staff. Our numbers will fluctuate with admissions and discharges along with hiring and the departure of staff.
