BACK IN 1959

Sixty-four years ago when Grand Traverse Medical Care was dedicated, the facility was the first countyowned medical care facility and health department in the State of Michigan. The four-story building was located at 410 Elmwood, adjacent to the Emergency Suite at Munson Hospital.


When it opened, Grand Traverse Medical Care Facility replaced the 22-bed Boardman Valley Hospital, which served the Elderly and indigent in the county since 1911. Grand Traverse Medical Care Facility was recognized as the "most advanced operation of its kind in Michigan." At the time, with the inception of Public Act 280, the facility along with 35 other county-owned medical care facilities in Michigan were mandated to serve the poor in rural Michigan. That obligation to care for the most vulnerable in our communities remains.



Service Excellence Award

We have an employee recognition program called the Service Excellence Award. This award and a \$25 gift card is given to an employee selected each week at random from a list of nominees. Residents and families as well as other staff can nominate an employee. The award is to recognize an employee who went above and beyond their normal duties.
