Did You Know?



We have 4 “Doggie Stations” on The Pavilions campus. The stations are located along the fire lane between The Rehab Center and Elmwood Ave, behind the Dogwood Pavilion, the sidewalk behind Aspen/ Birch Pavilion and the sidewalk in front of Evergreen Cottage, facing the Grand Lawn. The stations have bags as well as a waste receptacle for your convenience. Thank you.





Residents and their families will receive a short survey in July from our partner, We Care Connect, an Activated Insights company. We encourage everyone to take a few minutes to complete the survey and share honest feedback. Your input helps us continue improving the experience for our residents and families. Our goal is for every resident to feel welcome, safe, and cared for. Residents will receive the survey through email, text, and by phone. If they are not able to complete it through those methods, a family member will be given the opportunity to assist in its completion.



Sunny Weather!



Many residents will be participating in outdoor activities. Sunburns can occur quickly and certain medications can increase the chances of being burned.

If you will be accompanying residents outside for any length of time, please ask your nurse for sunscreen. He/she will be able to assist residents with the application of sunscreen.

Another preventative measure for minimizing the chance of a sunburn is to wear a large brimmed hat. By taking these simple measures, you can help prevent sunburn.



Temperature Changes

Please be patient with us as we continue to fine tune the temperature needs of our buildings for ultimate comfort for all of the residents. It is very difficult to regulate a building of this size when we are much colder at night than we are during the day.

We will be making frequent adjustments from day to day. When the warmer weather arrives consistently, we will then have the air conditioning running on a daily basis.

Leave of Absence Medication

If you are planning a Leave of Absence (LOA) at any time, please make your request for medications 72 hours in advance of the LOA. The nurses will be happy to package your medications and have them ready for pick up prior to your departure.

Item Drop Offs

We have had an item drop off table in our vestibule to allow families to drop items off to their loved ones without having to come inside. In consideration of this we want to remind families to clearly **LABEL** the items they are dropping off. If you do not have a way to label your item we ask that you please contact the front desk at **3001** using the vestibule phone, and we will help you label your items. If you are dropping off items after hours please contact your loved ones Pavilion using the numbers listed by the vestibule phone.

Power strips/adapters/plug ins

A friendly reminder that any electronic plug ins or power cords must be U.L. approved and inspected by the Environmental Services Dept.

Due to the state fire code and our policies, we do not allow any extension cords, outlet adapters or heating devices in resident rooms. For personal electronics, one hospital grade power strip may be used in resident rooms. If a hospital grade power strip is purchased, it must be inspected and installed by our Maintenance team.
