Family Updates

We are happy to report that our COVID outbreak has ended! We have not had a positive resident since November 24th nor a positive staff member since the 26th.

Grand Traverse Pavilions recognizes that the absence of visitors and family interaction has been difficult for our residents and their families. Visitation has opened up to in room visitations with current CDC and CMS guidelines. We do need to remind visitors of the vulnerability of our residents, and for their protection, and the protection of our valuable direct care staff, we are requiring visitors to come prepared by being fully masked and of good health (having no temperature or COVID symptoms). Please "help us" by being sensitive to the health and wellness of our vulnerable population by wearing a well-fitting mask during visitations in the coming weeks and months. For clarification, a "wellfitting" mask does not include bandanas or neck gaiters. Visitors are to bring and wear a proper fitting mask that covers the mouth and nose. Although the door is now "open" we caution you to please keep in mind COVID is still rampant throughout our community (14.81%) and you may potentially expose residents, or be exposed to COVID yourself, when visiting our facility. We ask before you visit you look at the Family Weekly update tab on our website to review visitation guidelines. You may also contact your loved ones ADON or Social worker for further information. We are excited for our residents and their families to once again be reunited.
